Key Duties and Responsibilities (but not limited to)

- To complete the attendance record on the Goal check report and issue corrective action notices and homework assignment slips as needed.
- To prepare and pull tests for next day tests, new PACEs when PACE Tests are passed, file old 'conferenced' PACEs and Tests. Prepare congratulation slips for successfully passed PACE Tests
- To keep scoring station and other areas of the learning centre clear of clutter.
- To ensure that the learning centre is in order at the end of the day and discreet remind supervisor of scheduled activities.
- To coordinate and answer non-academic flag questions and supervise breaks and lunch.
- To check student homework assignment slips, student goals and complete the Goal Check Report for the supervisor.
- To monitor scoring station, ensure students keep score keys and station neat. Issue de/merits, listen to monthly scripture memory verses, supervise detention time, and direct student attention to supervisor.
