- To participate in infants' feed calculations and nutritional management of those with malnutrition, under the guidance of the Nurse Supervisor.
- To maintain an up-to-date medical record and provide Clinical updates regarding infants to the Nurse Supervisor.
- To participate in health programmes within and outside Watoto as and when a need arises.
